



Participant Guidelines & Rules

1. Team Composition Guidelines

- Each team must consist of **exactly 4 students**.
- Each team must nominate **one Team Leader**, who will be the official point of contact with the organizers.

2. Team Registration Rules

- Every team must register with a **unique team name**.
- During registration, teams must submit:
 - Name of each participant
 - Department
 - Year of study
- Teams must complete registration **within the given deadline**.
- Once registered, **team details cannot be modified**.

3. Problem Statement Selection Rules

- Each team is allowed to select **only one problem statement**.
- Teams can participate in **only one category**:
 - **Software Hackathon** or
 - **Hardware Hackathon**
- A maximum of **2-3 teams** will be allowed to work on the same problem statement.
- Problem statements will be allotted on a **first-come, first-served basis**.
- Once a problem statement is allotted, **it cannot be changed**.

4. Participation Guidelines During the Hackathon

- All team members are expected to:
 - Actively participate in ideation, development, and presentation.
 - Share responsibilities equally within the team.
- Teams must manage:
 - Internal communication
 - Task allocation



- Time management effectively
- The solution developed must be:
 - Original
 - Relevant to the selected problem statement
 - Developed during the hackathon period

5. Code of Conduct for Participants

- All participants must follow the **institution's code of conduct** throughout the event.
- Participants must maintain:
 - Professional behavior
 - Mutual respect
 - A collaborative and inclusive environment
- Any form of misconduct, misbehavior, or disruption may lead to **immediate disqualification**.

6. Disqualification Criteria

A team may be disqualified if:

- The team violates **team composition or registration rules**.
- Any team member is found engaging in **plagiarism or copying existing solutions**.
- The solution is not aligned with the chosen problem statement.
- Teams attempt to change members or problem statements without approval.
- Any unethical practices are observed during the hackathon.

7. General Instructions

- The decision of the **judging panel and organizing committee will be final**.
- Organizers reserve the right to:
 - Modify rules if necessary
 - Disqualify teams violating guidelines
- Participants are advised to regularly check official announcements for updates.
