4.04 To consider the conduction of Supplementary Exams for Final Year, Final Semester students.













*Resolved to approve the Supplementary exams for Final semester alone for the final year students provided if the affiliating university (Anna University) approves the same.*

4.05 To consider the quality initiatives and factors influencing the growth of the institution

Suggested the following Quality initiatives like

1. UGC Nominee Dr Bhuvan Parekh appreciated the patents published by the institution and suggested to consider the outcome of patent as to convert it into prototype and in turn to a start-up company
2. Dr Bhuvan Parekh suggested to assess the Guest Lectures and other events conducted for the sake of students by feedback mechanism or in terms of Quiz or Viva

3. He suggested that for Computer science related New courses, the recruitment of staff should be done based on their specialization. Also suggested to post the specialization of the staff in the website so that students shall see that and register for elective courses as Choice based credit system.
4. Dr Bhuvan Parekh suggested to recruit professors for New courses in third year of the course and also to ensure new labs for the new courses.
5. UGC Nominee Dr Bhuvan Parekh and Industry nominee Ms Vidya Prabu suggested to buy a Public cloud space from Amazon/Microsoft/IBM etc to give hands on to students.
6. Industry nominee Ms Vidya prabu appreciated the institution for the initiatives taken for the Placement training and Value added courses and suggested to conduct Mock Interviews and Group discussion by the industry experts in the third year itself. And suggested to ensure that placed students should join the company to increase the joining ratio.
7. State Government Nominee Mr S Gopi appreciated the institution for the initiatives on certificate courses and expressed that these certificate courses are mostly for Computer science Engineering course and this initiative should be extended to other branch of engineering too.
8. Mr Gopi enquired about the usage of journals by the students and suggested to analyse the usage pattern on journals in order to go for purchase of such journals
9. University Nominee Dr S Srinivasan enquired whether Internship has been made mandatory to all students and the institution is already in the practice.
