POLICY FOR SLOW LEARNERS

- ❖ Faculty Advisors review grades scored in the previous end semester examination and suggest remedial action for improvement, wherever needed.
- ❖ Faculty Advisors assess the academic performance of students in every Assessments and also Monitor the attendance percentage. Faculty advisors discuss Assessment performance and Attendance report with parents to garner their support at regular Interval.
- ❖ To enhance students' performance, a question bank with answers is provided.
- ❖ No Students Left Behind (NSLB)- Remedial classes are organized for slow learners, providing individualized attention.
- ❖ Special revision sessions are held prior to the end-semester exams.
- ❖ Motivational programs featuring eminent speakers offer additional encouragement of Slow learners.
- ❖ Regular guest lectures allow students to interact with accomplished individuals.
- ❖ Staff members share educational YouTube videos for subjects, providing valuable study resources.
- ❖ Activity-based learning, including chart work, model demonstrations, and videos, aids students in better understanding the subject matter.

STRATEGIES FOR ADVANCED LEARNERS

- ❖ Students securing top three positions in End semester examinations are motivated by providing addition Library cards.
- ❖ Encouraging bright students to actively participate in paper presentation / Project presentations for international conferences, workshops, symposiums, and other competitions by providing On Duties(OD).
- ❖ Academic excellence Students are encouraged with cash prize & merit Certificates in Annual Day.

- ❖ Students having 100% attendance in each academic year are awarded with Merit Certificates in Annual Day.
- ❖ Students are members of various professional bodies and receive guidance to organize symposiums, Technical Events and Club activities which enhance their skills and also develop their leadership quality.
- ❖ Motivation is provided for students to enroll in MOOC courses such as Coursera, NPTEL and certificate courses, as well as to undertake In-plant Training and Internships.
- ❖ Students are urged to engage in mini-projects to enhance their technical skills.
- ❖ Participation in Project Expos is encouraged, allowing students to showcase their expertise across departments. Subject matter experts select the best project, and students receive certification and financial reward.
- ❖ The College ABHS team assists students in exploring opportunities for higher education overseas.
- ❖ Beyond the prescribed curriculum, students are exposed to e-content through national portals.
- ❖ Supplementary laboratory sessions are organized beyond the regular curriculum after college hours, providing an opportunity for proactive learners to enhance their knowledge.
